



Looking toward Easter . . .

Jesus died before Calvary!

Revelation 13:8b

"... the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world."



The death of Jesus Christ for the sins of this world was planned and executed in the mind of God before the creation of this world. We read the following in the Book of Revelation: "And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world." – Revelation 13:8 Jesus, prophetically, died before Calvary!

The Book of Revelation is a Prophetic Book but also a Devotional Book. Devotional stimulation always occurs when the Preeminent Saviour is seen. This Book, itself, is the "Revelation of Jesus Christ"!

I would call your attention to three suggested ideas seen in the above quoted verse. We can note: A Popular Religion, A Proving Registry, and A Planned Redemption. Mankind is incurably religious to include atheists and agnostics, for there is embedded in the human soul the reality of inferiority and the realization of someone or something of superiority. Today's culture is no exception, for atheism and its elements include a humanism which is a religion of self-attainment and power.

The Lamb's Book of Life is the proven registry of the redeemed. Those saved have their name recorded in that Book, and their name, in the Lamb's Book of Life, is the assurance that their name will not be blotted out of the Book of Life. "He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels." Revelation 3:5

Redemption was a planned redemption, planned before the foundation of the world, for Jesus was "the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world." The cross of Calvary was not an afterthought with God! God put thought into the salvation of the sinner and, furthermore, His redemption included you and me who have trusted Him for salvation. The omniscient God knew before the creation of this world every sinner who would be cleansed through the Blood of this, "the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world." *Oh Hallelujah, Oh what a Saviour!*

of hands to the next. As soon as they heard the words "right" or "left", the passing would quickly adjust accordingly for our alert listeners. The story was long, including snippets like this one: "His love surrounds us, **right** and **left**, in every moment of our lives. Even when we feel **left** alone, God is always **right** beside us **right** when we need Him most." The fast-paced passing provided a lot of laughs as the puppy made his rounds. For every round, whoever held him on the last word of the story got to choose a prize from the Valentine gift bag.

Next, we took a moment to ponder the many types of love we experience in this journey of life. Our intuitive young people, who always amaze us with their insightful answers, named over many aspects of love... parental love, sibling love, family love, friendship love, pet love, the sacrificial love that heroes feel for the rescued, and even patriotism, the stirring love felt for our homeland. Although the Valentine holiday focuses mainly on romantic love, we confirmed that there are countless objects of love to encounter in one human lifetime. None can compare, however, to the amazing and lasting love of God. Looking to the 139th Psalm, we are assured that He has not only wonderfully made us, but He also knows us thoroughly; He examines our hearts; and He sees our motives yet He loves us still. We shared one of Jennifer Marshall Bleakley's sweet devotional lessons, that shows how our devoted dogs often follow us around wherever we go... little "shadows" that are always by our sides. In a way, they are living, tangible reminders that the Lord Himself is faithfully beside us with every step we take. In fact, verse 5 paints a beautiful picture: "Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid Thine hand upon me." Positioning the stuffed puppy helped us visually demonstrate how our God accompanies His children in front of the toy, behind the toy, and above the toy. In the same way, Jesus not only goes before us, but He also follows us, and puts His hand of blessing upon our heads. Every moment, we are completely surrounded by His loving presence in every direction... before us, behind us, and above us. No wonder the next verse has the psalmist declare that such knowledge is too wonderful, and too great to understand. Truly, the scope of His perfect and unconditional love is beyond our grasping! How to Plant Well in a Spiritual Spring

How to Plant Well in a Spiritual Spring

I hadn't even known I was in winter. I was producing a lot — Sunday School lessons, women's ministry events, missionary newsletters, not to mention three meals a day for my family — so how could my soul possibly be frozen? Then, a shift. A wake-up call. A crack in the ice that told me my heart was nearing a change. In Alaska, they call this breakup. The thick river ice, once a highway for snowmobiles, literally breaks up and flips completely over to begin its journey to the ocean. It's the official signal for spring, regardless of the calendar date.

When my wintering soul began its breakup process, I at first mistook it for a breakdown. And it could have been, but for God. When He starts waking and shaking things up inside it can be a painful process, but if we tune into the work His Spirit is doing and join Him in tilling the packed earth of our hearts, new growth will surely follow.

If winter is marked by silence, then spring is marked by noise. Particularly, the voice of the Lord. God is never silent, but in winter He is harder to hear. And while you may have been in a season of rest or, like I did, continued to push through in order to meet expectations during the barrenness of winter, spring will compel you to get up and get your hands dirty. God calls to you almost audibly in spring. You can resist it or ignore it, telling Him, "I like my armchair by the fireplace thank-youvery-much," but you'll be missing one of the greatest opportunities for personal growth and planting in His service.

Springtime is an invitation from the Lord to sow seeds.

"Vindication. Restoration. Sanctification. Emotional renewal, physical renewal, moral renewal: these herald spring. They're what spring produces in rich profusion. They are gifts and they are invitations. The opportunity spring provides—to grow things in abundance—can be missed or seized."

INDICATORS OF A SPIRITUAL SPRING OF THE SOUL

- You're being awakened to needed changes in your life.
- You have a renewed hunger for God.
- God's word is fresh and exciting and personal.
- Something new is on the horizon of your life (A word of caution here: Often after a big transition the springtime excitement heads straight into the bitter struggles of winter. Don't be alarmed if it takes a few seasons longer than you'd like to start seeing fruit in a new area. This seems to be a normal part of the process, just like how a tree that is transplanted will take a dormant season above ground to grow strong roots below ground.)
- You're going through significant healing, perhaps from past wounds or even a physical ailment.
- Energy! Enthusiasm! You truly want to serve God.
- Buried dreams are resurfacing and you sense an invitation from the Lord to explore them again.
- How many of these indicators of spring resonate with you right now?

If you're not in the renewal of spring or the abundance of summer, remember that the sorrow of autumn and the silence of winter are what make spring and summer possible. Don't rush through your spiritual seasons. Find whatever deep work God is doing in your soul and simply meet Him there.
